The proposed new building forms a pedestrian link between Lukiškių Square and the right bank of the Neris river. Instead of the present pedestrian bridge, a new road bridge is proposed, and the present pedestrian bridge is to be constructed on the second-storey level above A. Goštauto Str. The pleasant public pedestrian precinct separates clearly the historic Dominican monastery and St James Church from the new building.
